Business License: All business owners, Business license renewals were due May 1st. A penalty of 50% of balance due will be added after June 15th and 100% of balance due (doubled) after August 1st 2017. All license renewals not received by May 15th are subject to \$75.00 non compliance fee. This includes home vacation rentals such as through AirBnB and VRBO and transient businesses.
