Welcome: Mayor Scott Chesnut welcomed the people and called the meeting of April 10, 2014 to order at 6:00 pm. Mayor Chesnut stated that this meeting was the regular monthly meeting. Colleen explained to the new council members that the numbers represent all accounts the town has with each number representing a different category of the budget. She also explained how to read all the data she gave the council members.

Now is the time to start thinking of next year's budget and planning capital projects that the town may want to pursue. She explained how and what capital projects are. She gave each council member a form to fill out to make a budget for their department, and to list capital projects the town may want to look at. She asked them to bring them back for the May Meeting.

Maintenance Chad Williams: Chad reported that the Chlorination Station is completed, and he is waiting for parts for it to become operational. Several new meters have been installed. Doug Robinson asked the question as to where the main chlorination station was located and Chad explained it was just below Birch Springs.

Last month there was discussion on laying sod and installing a sprinkler system at the Big Apple. Chad was able to find some grass that requires less water and he said the town had parts for a sprinkler system. The Lees would like the money raised from the sale of the book "Our Beloved Torrey" to go towards the purchase of the sod. The amount raised from the sale would be about \$700.00

Pat Kearney gave an update of the website. Everything is ok and she encouraged everyone to use the website. Pat also said she was the one that put the wrong date on the website and apologized for that error.

Council member Pat Kearney gave an update of the Tour of Utah. There will be banners advertising Tour of Utah as well as a stamp on highway 24 as one comes into Torrey. One can now sign up to volunteer on the Tour of Utah Website. Also, she asked people to be thinking about a special gift that would be representative of Torrey that could be presented to the winner of the race. One of the biggest changes would be that people will be able to cross the street from north to south in several places. Last year all roads were blocked off. Tour of Utah people will move in on August 4 and will probably be out of here by 6:00 on Tuesday night August 5th. Activities will be going on at the park and the hope is that people will find it to be a very festive occasion. Pat also showed a Bicycling Magazine that had pictures of some of the recognizable formations in our area.

Michelle Colman. Adus Dorsey served on the Highway 12 committee but he has resigned and they are in need of a new representative. There will be a meeting on April 15th in Panguitch and until we can find a replacement, the Mayor asked Chad Williams to attend the meeting and

serve as the representative. Michelle also said the town needed a person to serve on the economic development committee. It was suggested that Ty Markham be this person. Ty said she would think about it and let the council know.

Brandon Jensen from the county gave an update of the bike path. The cost will be approximately 1.1million dollars. The office has the book of plans and it can be found on the Wayne county website as a download if anyone would like to look at it. The project is going forward and funding is being gathered to help finance the bike path.

Sign Ordinance. The sign ordinance is still being adjusted and hopefully the council can take a vote on it next month. The Mayor Chesnut, would like some time to look at the sign ordinance, since he is new to the council. The sign ordinance will be discussed at the work meeting next month.

Clerk Paula Pace asked the new council members for their contact information. She also that each council member contact Whitney and get a password to him so they could get their website address set up.

An update was given on the office remodel. We are accepting bids until the 24th of April. The council will then decide who to award it to at the next meeting and the work will begin shortly after that.

The council approved for the office to purchase recording equipment to record the town meetings.
