Maintenance Report. Dustin Oyler: Two fans have been installed in the pavilion, screens in the pavilion. The Burdock growing along the canal is a concern and needs spraying so it does not spread everywhere. There is also the weed White top that needs spraying.

Building permit. Steve Babbitt has requested a building permit but before the planning and zoning can approve it, he needs to get a copy of the lighting ordinance and show his lighting plans for approval by the P&Z.

Paul Dixon. In response to the letter, the town received from Mr. Dixon the council asked that the clerk write a letter explaining again that we do not have a Kennel Ordinance and the ordinance states only 3 dogs. The council also said this would probably turn into a civil matter.

Mary Bedingsfield Smith. Lighting project update: There are 16 lights to replace in town including the café Diablo. The cost to replace the lights will be \$7650.

I.O.B.Y Budget. The town will partnership with Entrada for the campaign to replace all the lights. The Campaign will be called Dark Skies Over Torrey. The kick off date will be July 1 and the end is date is September 24. The Town lights will be first, next we will replace the private lights of individuals who agree to do so. There will also be an education campaign to educate the business to the advantages of having dark sky friendly lights. We will also educate tourists as well as individuals. There will be a Linton Rohr Dark Sky Exhibit at the visitor center at the junction of Highways 24 and 12. A total of \$18,000 is needed to accomplish all the necessary cost of replacing, town and individual lights, maintenance and education.

Mary BedingfieldSmith reported on the pathway through Torrey. Marci Mulligan would like the town in good faith to donate \$1000.00 to help secure the remaining funds for the pathway.

Motion The town will pledge \$1000.00 toward the pathway to help secure funding.

John Dillenbeck...He was concerned about the condition of the road on the roundabout. He would like road base and Gravel on the road, Juniper Dr. The roundabout needs to be opened up to the proper width and the council suggested that Ensign Engineering come back and survey the roundabout and the road to determine the road width and ownership. We will check with the county recorder Colleen Allen, to see how it is recorded. Dustin will contact the surveyor. John Dillenbeck said he would like to help with a donation to the town, to help with the project. Colleen Duddleston the treasure will call Colleen Allen the county recorder, for the minutes concerning the Red Gates subdivision of Dick Davis to see what the arrangement was for roads of the subdivision.

Nathan Chappell is representing Myrle Allred; the project is a CUD. (Community Unit Development.) The water is the big concern. The town would not be able to supply all the necessary water that would be required to develop the project. He wanted to develop a small division of five cottage type units each one would be individually owned and this would require each house to have an individual hookup. The council decided they could develop three parcels, but absolutely no subdivisions, as we do residences only. He was considering small cabins with bathrooms. He has 10.8 acres.

Tour of Utah. The Contract for Tour of Utah has been given to the TOU People and there will be a meeting on 8 July to finalize some of the loose ends. Dustin needs to attend to receive information about the town's part in setting up the footprint.

Jamin Brinley is the new Town hire for the summer.
