

**Torrey Town Minutes**

**Welcome:** Mayor Adus Dorsey welcomed and called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. The mayor stated that the meeting was a regularly scheduled meeting. A motion to approve the minutes with one correction of the March 10, 2011 meeting was made by Jamie Austin and seconded by Janet Hansen. All voted in favor.

**Financial report:** Colleen Dudleston gave the Bank reconciliation. She highlighted the expenses that are not a monthly expense. She explained each expense. She shared the conference agenda with the council Colleen will be attending a budget conference in Park City and she shared with the council the agenda of some of the meetings she would be attending. On April 19<sup>th</sup> she will be going a budget workshop sponsored by Peloris. Colleen also explained the deposits that came into the budget. She also explained the B and C road budget and how it works. We receive deposits about every 9 weeks. Colleen gave an accounting of the business licenses and the dog licenses. The town has received approximately 600.00 in business lic. money. The question came up as to how do we want to handle late licensing. To date about 30 Sand creek water shares have been leased. We have received 760.00 at this point.

Each council member received an accounting of their budgets. Colleen expressed that they need to turn in their budgets for next year by the May meeting so we can prepare the 2011-12 budget. Colleen explained how we would adjust and amend the 2010-11 budget if we needed to do so. She also explained the two insurance policies we hold with The Leavitt Group and the Utah League of Cities.

**Council members Reports:**

Mayor gave an update on Curtis Cook and his condition after suffering a heart attack. Councilmember Jen Howe is out of town.

**Janet Hansen: Park Report.** Volley ball net is here. The bouncing duck and swing set has been shipped and will arrive within the next two weeks. They are being purchased with a grant of \$5000.00 received from the Wayne County Special Service District. Janet asked if we could give a special thank you and a certificate of appreciation to Ron Moosman and Howard Blackburn for their help with the trees. On April 1 the town planted 8 trees along the fence on the west side of the park. Mayor Dorsey welcomed the volunteers that helped and a lunch of soup, rolls and cake was served. We are going to have another Arbor Day event toward the end of April. Janet Hansen attended a Tree City workshop in Springdale and won two hundred dollars for the town. The prize came from Rocky Mountain Power. She would like to use this money to plant trees at the cemetery.

### **Mayor Report**

Mayor Dorsey also reported on the Arbor Day celebration held by the town. He appreciated the help that was there to assist in planting the trees. A dumpster will be here for the town clean up. No date was set.

The town now has a form for people who would like to express their concerns or complaints. The policy is anyone wanting action from the council would need to fill out the form and the council will take it under advisement. The Mayor just felt the town needs to have the concerns on file so the council will have something to look at before taking any action.

The CCC form will be on the town website. The Planning and Zoning committee met and they are moving along on their assignments for annexation and the town plan. Mayor Dorsey attended a Six County summit meeting and gave a report.

### **New Business**

The question came up about acquiring new Christmas lights for the town. The cost would be approximately \$2200.00 for eight snowflake lights to be placed on the street poles. It was suggested the town seek donations to help defer the cost of the lights. One suggestion was to have a booth at the Big Apple Days to take donations. Another one was to put it in the Town News Letter.

Torrey has an outstanding citizen each year in the Big Apple Days Parade and the council was asked to come up with some criteria that would help the town select this citizen. We will also ask for town input in selecting the outstanding citizen.

### **Community and Citizen Concerns.**

There was no input from the community at this meeting

Colleen Dudleston and Paula Pace explained the budget time line and dates that would be necessary to set the 2011-2011 budget.

A motion to adjourn was made by Janet Hansen and seconded by Jamie Austin. The meeting adjourned at 7:47.
