Cross-Connection & Backflow Prevention

After using a hose attachment to spray his lawn for weeds, Bob disconnected the attachment and took a drink of water from the hose; a short time later Bob became very ill.

What Happened?

At some time while Bob was spraying the week killer, the water pressure dropped and the poison he was spraying on the lawn was drawn back up into the hose. When Bob took a drink from the hose, he drank water mixed with week killer.

If Bob had a **hose bibb vacuum breaker** on his hose connection, he could have prevented this cross-connection.


