Welcome: Mayor Scott Chesnut welcomed all present expressed that this was a regular scheduled council meeting of January 9, 2020.

The first order of business was the swearing in of the new council members Doug Robinson and Jordan Pace. This was done by the clerk Paula Pace.

Motion was made to approve the minutes of December 14, 2019. Motion was made by Pat Kearney and seconded by Pearl Throndal-Stewart. All were in favor; motion passed.

Rob Fraizer, representing The Mooney Wash Boys, presented a check for \$2011.00 to Karen Rohr for the Dark Skies Project. The money is gratuities from the Mooney Wash boys collected from playing at the Farmers Market and Old House at Center and Main during the summer. Karen was very appreciative of the donation.

Financial Report: Colleen Dudleston was excused. Clerk Paula Pace gave a short summary of what year end reports had been done. The council ask if a report could be sent to them via e-mail.

Maintenance Report: Dustin reported that there was \$35000 left grant money left, and he suggested replacing the 4-inch water line along 300 W to 200 W to an 8 in line. These was discussion whether to do two blocks or one. If we do two, money will have to come from the rainy-day fund. The Council decided to just do one block. Motion Doug Robinson made the motion to just do one block and Pat Kearney seconded all were in favor and motion passed. The new Spring Project development is coming along. We are waiting on the Forrest Service to give the town information on administration fees. Work will begin as soon as bids are complete hopefully in the early spring. All Christmas lights are gathered up except those that are frozen in the ground.

No licenses, permits, or water connections.

Mayor Chesnut Asked new councilmember Jordan Pace to be over the streets and cemetery. All other council members would remain the same. Pat Kearney Parks and trees. Doug Robinson Water, Pearl Thorndal-Stewart the planning and zoning.

Water Report: Doug reported that work has begun on the springs. They will meet with the engineers in a week. NCRS has been difficult to work.

Pat Kearney reported that we are in line for the lease on the BLM property that the town once leased.

Planning and Zoning. Pearl. Thorndal-Stewart Pearl ask if Bill Barrett could come to next month's meeting and present to the council the dynamics of the county. The planning and zoning would like draft 6 of the zoning ordinance to be sent to the lawyers David Church and Richard Chamberlain. Clerk, Paula Pace will call them and tell them we would like them to look over the draft and try to have it back around the 1st of February to publicize for the public meeting. Three of the commission are up for term renewal: the members are Richard Jensen, Tracy Potter, Arron Jensen. The council would like to reappoint all three. If they the members choose not to be reappointed the council will then advertise.

A letter will be sent to Cathy Bagley and Mr. Butler stating that the town will take over the water line and assume responsibility. The line has been tested and approved to have water run-through it. The town assumes no responsibility in recouping any money for Mr. Butlers expenses.

Mary Bedingsfield-smith thanked Dustin for his work with the Christmas decorations.

Motion to adjourn was made by Pat Kearney and seconded by Pearl. All were in favor motion passed. Meeting was adjourned at 7:15
