Welcome: Mayor Scott Chesnut expressed that this was a regular scheduled council meeting of April 9, 2020.

Approval of Minutes Motion made by Pat Kearney to approve minutes seconded by Doug Robinson all were in favor motion passed.

Financial Report Colleen Dudleston Colleen presented the bill and expenses to the council and answered several questions about some of the expenditures. Councilmember asked about the high cost for propane and an explanation was given. Colleen said the report from Kimball and Roberts audit suggested highly that the town not take on any new projects this next fiscal year. Our budget is a little leaner with the loss of some sales and use tax. Colleen believes we can sustain ourselves if we are frugal with our spending.

The motion was made to approve and pay the bills. Motion was made by Pat Kearney and seconded by Pearl Thorndal-Stewart. All were in favor motion passed.

Maintenance Report Dustin Oyler: Dustin reported the water line project will be completed next week with the tie in hoping to be done on Tuesday. Water for the cemetery and park will be turned on next week. The doors for the pavilion will be finished up next week. Rain gutters will be needed for the pavilion and the solar Panels will be completed next week. The Kiosk is being constructed and when it is finished it will be a nice place to post advertisements and announcements.

Invited Guests. Micky Wright: Micky gave and updated report on the purchase and licensing of Windows 365d. He has several bids and the council instructed him to get the best deal for the office.

Council reports:

Water Doug Robinson: Projects coming along. The Sandcreek irrigation problem of distributing the water, will remain the same as it is at this time. Metering is not an option right now. Scott will check with the attorney to see what other options might be available to the town.

Parks /Trees Pat Kearney: Arbor Days has been cancelled. The Dumpster will be in front of the Fire Station on April 27th-30th. We need to get that information out to the townspeople. Pat also suggested that the town cancel Apple days this year due to the Covid-19 pandemic. This makes it hard to plan anything not knowing the future. The members of the council agreed.

P&Z Pearl Thorndal-Stewart: The P&Z held their meeting and continued to work on the zoning draft.

Roads and Cemetery. Jordan Pace: Signs have been placed on Center street and the stop signs have been corrected. Cemetery needs to be prepared for Memorial Day. Mel Pace is working on the Cemetery project with the grant the town received.

Clerk Paula Pace: All letters have been sent to the various people regarding the loss of the post office in Torrey.

Unfinished Business: Sandcreek Irrigation this was handled and discussed earlier.

New business Discussion items and Mayor Report:

Summer help. Mel Pace who was hired last summer will be retained this summer to work on the Cemetery project and help with office duties. The building of the New Fire House in Torrey is scheduled to begin in July. The County Fire Department has received a grant to build it. The fire house will be the hub of the county fire department.

No public comments.
