**Welcome:** Mayor Scott Chesnut expressed that this was a regular scheduled council meeting of June 11, 2020.

Motion made by Pat Kearney to approve the minutes of May 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020 seconded by Pearl Thorndal- Stewart. All were in favor motion passed.

**Financial Report Colleen Dudleston** Colleen answered all concerns from the preceding month about the financial report. Colleen said she has had several requests to do the water bills by E mail. She will have it ready to go next month. The expense on River drive was for a water line repair and replaced meter. The unusually high Propane bill was because a payment was late or missed in January, but it is now fixed.

**Motion to accept and pay the bill was made by Pearl Thorndal-Stewart and seconded by Jordan Pace all were in favor. Motion passed**

***Motion to approve and accept the 2020- 21 fiscal budget with the increase of 400 dollars for the sod was made by Pat Kearney and seconded by Jordan Pace.***

**Maintenance Report Dustin Oyler** Absent.

**Bruce Phillips** Bruce is wanting to split his property into three pieces. He had questions about what type of structure could go on his property. Bruce was also concerned about the large animal ordinance. The council is working on the livestock problem and the person has been contacted and the issue should be resolved soon.

**Mark Bailey.** He explained his water leak and asked the town for water forgiveness. The bill was 237.00 and the council said because he was diligent in getting the leak repaired, they would not charge him the overage. **The motion was made by Pearl Thorndal-Stewart and seconded by Pat Kearney; all were in favor motion passed.**

**Jeremy Deakin** He was not present, but the council also forgave his overage because of a leak. **The motion was made by Jordan Pace and seconded by Pat Kearney. All were in favor motion passed.**

**Mickey Wright.** Mickey updated the council on X Mission. Colleen will need call GSA. As soon as she does our office e-mail will work. Micky will educate the office as how to work the new x Mission.

### **Council Reports**

**Dustin Oyler** The sod will be here Monday. Any help would be welcome. Bids for the spring development will go out next week and will be open on July 7<sup>th</sup>

**Pat Kearney Parks and trees.** Pat was able to acquire, plastic chairs for the park and pavilion for a nominal price. These chairs will be especially useful for activities the town sponsors.

**Pearl Thorndal Stewart: Planning and Zoning.** The zoning ordinance is moving along. They hope to hold their public hearing soon. Mary Beddingfieldsmith said the commission is working on the Sign, Fencing, and nuisance ordinance.

**Jordan Pace Roads and Cemetery.** It is hard to mow up Sandcreek because ATVs are making the road in terrible condition. Riding on the shoulder and not the blacktop is breaking away the edges. It was suggested that we place boulders along the shoulder of the road, to prevent people from riding there. People still need to slow down on center street, but the signs have helped. The signs of children playing need to be put up for the traffic going south. Pearl suggested that a message about speeding on Center be placed in the water bill. Trees in the cemetery need water; and the cages around the trees need to be adjusted.

Paula Pace Clerk gave an update on the Torrey Post office. The blue pickup box is ready, just waiting for the scanner. The proposal the town made to house the post office boxes is being considered.

Council member asked about a threatened Lawsuit from Leon Chappell. She was wondering what precipitated it and what has since happened. Mayor Chesnut explained t the town lifted the moratorium of out of town water hookups and the problem was solved.
