

**Application:**

**To Place a Citizen's Referendum on the  
November 2021 Municipal Election Ballot**

On April 8, 2021 the Torrey Town Council adopted amendments to the town's zoning ordinance. This was a legislative act, altering the zoning law in Torrey.

The proposed referendum will ask Torrey residents to repeal the inclusion of gas stations in the amended zoning ordinance. Specifically, we ask for: repeal of the listing of gas stations contained in Appendix A - Table of Uses; repeal of the definition of "Selling of Gasoline and Diesel" contained in Appendix C - Definitions; and repeal of Appendix F - Sale of Gasoline and/or Diesel Standards in its entirety. These three deletions are highlighted on the attached sheet.

This application is being filed with the town clerk of Torrey, in accordance with the Utah referendum code 20A-7-Part 6. It is being submitted by five sponsors whose names are below, and whose signature pages and certifications are attached.
